3 Hoop Casings Halsey Onstage

instructions brought to you by Travis Halsey & Carole Klinko.

- 1. Cut a strip 1.5" to 3" wide for each piece of netting in your hooped row. Stitch both edges of it to your hooped row.
- that will be gathered. Stitch a channel 1.5" to 3" wide. You can gather 2. Lay 2 consecutive rows together making sure to line up the edges
- If your hoop row is to be cut at 11" and you'd like a casing that is 1" wide Stitch a fold into your hoop row. You must add extra netting to do so 1" fold and end with an 11" row. You can stitch the folded edge down add twice the casing. You would now cut this row 13", stitch in your both inner edges at the same time or gather them separately. f you'd like, but it's not necessary.
 - Usually your hoop goes in row 5, 6, or 7.
- When deciding how far from the edge to place your casing keep these further out the hoop the flatter it will stay. Partnering is the third factor, he closer to the body the more droop a tutu will acquire over time, the edge that it will be disguised by the previous (shorter) layer. Second, 3 factors into mind. First it needs to be far enough in from the outer now much hoop can the male dancer handle?
